What is **Responsible Party**?

Responsible Party is a pan-European campaign to raise awareness among students about responsible drinking and contribute to the reduction of excessive and inappropriate consumption of alcohol among students. The campaign is a joint collaboration between Pernod Ricard and ESN, and it forms part of their Corporate Social Responsibility work. Local ESN sections all over Europe are organizing parties with an additional label called "Responsible Party" to show students a safe and responsible way of partying and having fun.

What are the **tasks** of NRPC?

- Collects information on the Responsible Parties organized in Finland.
- Follows the international RP team and forwards information from the international level to the national and local level
- Has presentations and/ or workshops in National Platforms
- Is the link between Pernod Ricard and the local project coordinators/ sections

What is **expected** from a NRPC

- Good social skills, enthusiasm and interest in the project are necessary for the coordinator.
- Able to motivate others to participate in the projects and knows how to intrigue people to participate
- Knowledge on the project and previous participation in Responsible Parties are appreciated.
