### National Section Coordinator

National Section Coordinator (aka. NSC) is the communication link between the National Board (NB) and the sections. NSC's main task is to look after the most important part of whole ESN, the local sections, help them with all their problems and needs, as well as provide information and assistance.

NSC is also responsible for managing the participants on all the communication channels used to forward information from the NB to the sections such as the Local Representatives Mailing List and other channels such as Slack and Facebook, as well as making sure the Section information document, which contains all the contact information of the sections and the members of the local boards, is up to date.

When the NB needs information from the sections, or there is for example a national order taking place, NSC is the one collecting the information. In addition, NSC's job is also to search for new potential sections and help interested groups to form a section.

The National Section Coordinator is also the NB member responsible of organising and chairing the Council of Local Representatives (aka CLR)

Also providing guidelines and documents and increasing the understanding of the importance of the Local Representative's position position as local board members in charge of forwarding the information from the NB to their boards.

The amount of work and time the position requires depends a lot on how active the NSC wants to be with communication with the sections, and also how actively the sections contact the NSC about their issues. Ideally the applicants for this position must show high motivation and be eager to improve and increase their knowledge and skills throughout the mandate.
