

Open Call for National **SocialErasmus** Coordinator of ESN Finland (term until 31.5.2016)

Are you looking for a new challenge? Are you interested in organising events with social impact? Are you eager to coordinate projects and develop your management skills? Are you interested in contributing to one of the biggest projects of ESN?



If you answered yes to even one of these questions - it's time to start writing your application for the **National SocialErasmus Coordinator** (later NSEC) of ESN Finland! We are looking for a person who is eager to develop this interesting project in Finland together with the NB responsible.

So who is the NSEC? The NSEC is the link between the International SocialErasmus team and the Local SocialErasmus Coordinators. The most important tasks of the NSEC are to train, motivate and support the Local SocialErasmus Coordinators in Finland and inform the sections about the updates related to SocialErasmus. The NSEC is also responsible for establishing potential partnerships with organisations engaged in activities related to SocialErasmus.

What do I need to know? It doesn't matter if you don't know every tiny little detail about SocialErasmus – you will learn by doing and will receive support from the international team. Tasks of the NSEC:

- Keep the National Board updated about activities happening in the local and international level regarding the project
- Work on increasing the quality of the SocialErasmus events in Finland and increase the amount of events during the SocialErasmus Weeks in Autumn and Spring.
- Get all the sections involved.

What do I get from it? SocialErasmus is a great project full of opportunities. This is your chance to be creative and take care of one of the biggest projects of ESN on a national level. Through the NSEC position you will have the chance to work together with people who share similar interests and network, gain more knowledge about ESN and attend the NP of ESN

Finland in spring. But most importantly, you will continue developing the social impact of this project in Finland!

In the application you should shortly introduce yourself, your experience in ESN and in SocialErasmus and what are your ideas for the position of ESN Finland's NSEC. The application should not be longer than one page.

You should know about the 8 causes of SocialErasmus. As the official SocialErasmus slogan says: **Leave your mark!**
